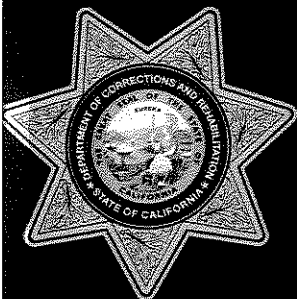

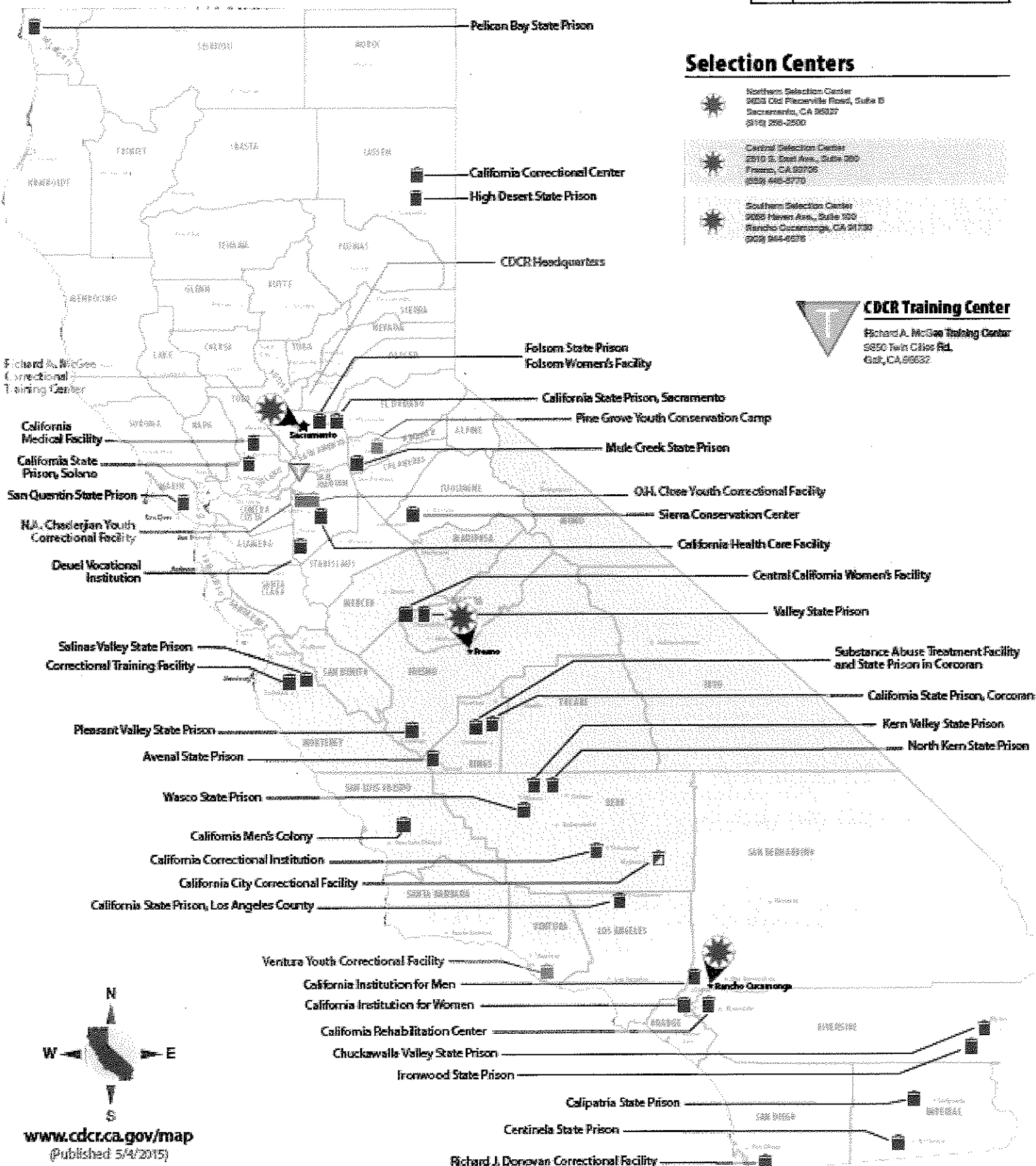

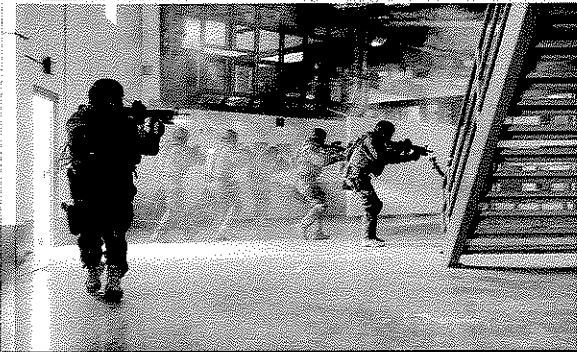

CRISIS RESPONSE TEAMS (CRT)

CRTs respond to emergency situations inside the institutions as well as working in conjunction with local law enforcement agencies if the need arises. Individuals on these teams receive training with special weapons.

CAMP OFFICERS

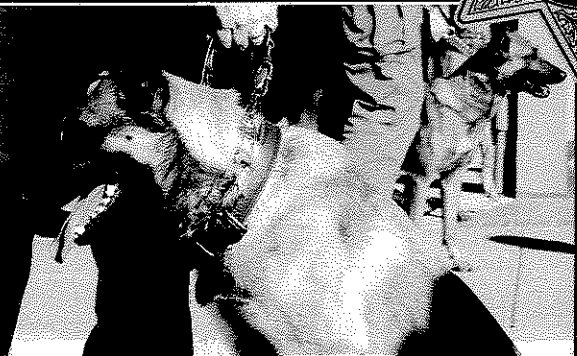
Correctional Officers are assigned to each of the 42 Conservation camps located throughout the State. These officers receive specialized training in wildland firefighting and work in cooperation with CAL FIRE and the Los Angeles County Fire Department during emergencies such as fires, floods, and natural disasters.

K-9 HANDLERS

K-9 Handlers complete training along with their K-9s for narcotics detection or contraband detection, such as cell phones and tobacco.

RANGEMASTER

Rangemasters train and qualify CDCR peace officers in the proper use and handling of departmental firearms and chemical agents. They also maintain, service and repair of departmental firearms.

PROMOTIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

The California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation offers a variety assignments and promotional opportunities. Correctional Officers are eligible for promotion after successfully completing their two-year apprenticeship program and promotional exam. Where do you want your career to take you?

TRADITIONAL PROMOTIONAL CAREER PATH

- Correctional Officer \$4,438-\$7,411 per month
- Correctional Sergeant \$6,591-\$8,288 per month
- Correctional Lieutenant \$7,403-\$9,315 per month
- Correctional Captain \$9,505-\$10,877 per month

PEACE OFFICER CAREER PATHS

Examples of career path opportunities include: Correctional Officer, Youth Correctional Officer, Correctional Counselor, Youth Correctional Counselor, Parole Agent, and Special Agent. Some classifications may require additional education and experience; promotional opportunities are available within each career path.

SPECIALIZED OPERATIONS

Examples of specialized operations include: Background Investigation Unit, Division of Facility Planning, Fugitive Apprehension Team, Emergency Operations Unit, Criminal Intelligence Analysis Unit, Range and Tactical Unit, Office of Internal Affairs, Board of Parole Hearing Investigations Unit, Board of Parole Hearings Investigations Unit, Extradition Unit and more.

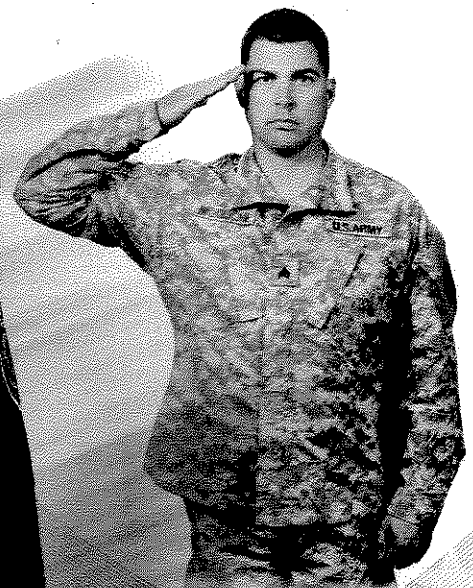
POST - 9/11 GI BILL



PUT YOUR MILITARY EXPERIENCE TO WORK!



The Post - 9/11 GI Bill is a 36 month tax free education benefit program administered by the Department of Veteran Affairs for individuals who served on active duty after September 10, 2001. Applicants for the classification of Correctional Officer may be eligible to receive the Post - 9/11 GI Bill if they served at least 90 aggregate days on active duty after September 10, 2001. Post - 9/11 GI Bill eligibility is determined by the Department of Veteran Affairs.

WHAT IS THE POST 9/11 GI BILL ENTITLEMENT?

While attending an approved program, applicants who meet all Post - 9/11 GI Bill requirements may receive the basic allowance for housing (BAH) payable at the military E-5 with dependents rate.

EXAMPLES:

- A qualifying Cadet who meets all criteria listed above may receive the following monthly salary:

Academy Pay	\$3,608.00*
9/11 GI Bill Entitlement	\$2,108.00
Total	\$5,716.00

- A qualifying entry-level Correctional Officer may receive the following monthly salary:

Entry Level Correctional Officer	\$4,438.00
9/11 GI Bill Entitlement for San Quentin	\$2,936.00
Total	\$7,374.00

*Pay increase of 5% every 6 months for 2 years.

*Approximate Academy pay based on \$20.82 per hour.
